Where and When:

Youth are asked to begin fasting on Friday, February 17th at 4:00 pm. During the fast, youth may drink juice and water. We even freeze juice to make popsicles. Meet at the Woodlake Campus on Friday at 6:30 pm. Parents and Youth will take part in a devotion and introduction to the events for the weekend. Parents will leave at 7:00 pm and the experience will begin!

On Friday night, youth will participate in activities revolving around famine and homelessness. They will sleep in cardboard boxes outside that night. On Saturday, the youth will do a service project and several other activities. We will end the famine by attending the 5:30 pm Connect service and then enjoying a home-cooked meal together. - Optional: Camera, Flashlight

(Please pack juice, sleeping bag, pillow and blankets separate from all other things.)

- Food
- Alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs
- Fireworks or any kind of weapon
- Water guns or water balloons
- Clothing with profanity
- Short shorts/skirts
- Electronics (including cell phones, ipods, etc.)
